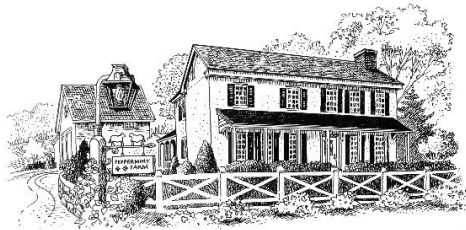

Background

The Bucks County Designer House & Gardens is a fundraising event sponsored by the Village Improvement Association of Doylestown (VIA). Professional interior designers and landscapers are invited to use their imagination, skills, and talent to transform an area home into a stunning estate. The residence, outbuildings and grounds are then opened in May for public tours.



Location

Tour Peppermint Farm, a c. 1860 farmhouse, outbuildings, and gardens after premier area designers and landscapers transform this charming property. Appropriately named for peppermint, the main crop that was grown on the property, this 30-acre farmstead includes a six-bedroom farmhouse, a two-car garage with a workshop, the base of a bank barn, a milk house, a studio, and storage shed. This farmhouse features unique built-ins, deep curved window sills, exposed beams, random width wood floors, stone floors, and two covered porches.

Peppermint Farm at 2613 Hilltown Pike in Perkasie, PA is conveniently located one mile from the historic Pearl S. Buck Estate and across the road from the Bishop Estate Vineyard and Winery. Lunch options including salads and sandwiches prepared daily by Simply Fresh by McCaffrey's may be pre-ordered from the Designer House Café.
